Utilized the Design Build delivery model. Early structural packages were provided to accelerate construction. The building opened well ahead of schedule as a result of exceptional collaboration between the owner, design, & construction team members



A 2-story 212,000 SF health care center that provides outpatient services and offices for support staff located in Butler, Pennsylvania. The new clinic offers primary and specialty care, mental health, dental, diagnostic and laboratory, radiology, rehabilitation, and women's health services.

The building features a large front entrance canopy with 2-story curtain wall glazing. A centralized main corridor through the building links the entrance and lobby space with the main clinical areas within. The majority of clinical services are arranged on the ground floor to enhance efficiency and minimize distances of travel for the public within the building.

The building exterior utilizes traditional brick masonry, curtain wall, and blast resistant glazing. Some portions of the lower façade and the mechanical penthouse are clad in an insulated metal panel system. Several areas in the lobby and campus security offices utilized ballistic rated glass to meet the VA security requirements. All exterior envelope components were engineered to resist a blast and progressive collapse event.

The project achieved a LEED silver certification.
